1 Peter 1:20-21 NLT

God chose him as your **ransom** long before the world began, but now in these last days he has been revealed for your sake. Through Christ you have come to trust in God. And you have placed your faith and hope in God because he raised Christ from the dead and gave him great glory.

**Adam** and **Eve**

Exodus 12:11-13 NLT

“These are your instructions for eating this meal: Be fully dressed, wear your sandals, and carry your walking stick in your hand. Eat the meal with urgency, for this is the LORD’s Passover. On that night I will pass through the land of Egypt and strike down every firstborn son and firstborn male animal in the land of Egypt. I will execute judgment against all the gods of Egypt, for I am the LORD! But the blood on your doorposts will serve as a sign, marking the houses where you are staying. When I see the blood, I will pass over you. This plague of death will not touch you when I strike the land of Egypt.

We have left God’s paths to follow our own. Yet the LORD laid on him the sins of us all. He was oppressed and treated harshly, yet he never said a word. **He was led like a lamb to the slaughter.**”

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look! **The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!**

Palm Sunday: **Lamb** Selection Day

**Crucifixion**

**Excruciating**

Shofar sounds **twice** a day, 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM

Sin brings death, a lamb has been sacrificed for sin.

Sin brings death

Jesus was crucified at **9:00 AM**

After three hours the **sky grew dark**

Jesus died at **3:00 PM**

Jesus is our Passover Lamb, without blemish or spot

1 Peter 1:18-19 NLT

For you know that God paid a ransom to save you from the empty life you inherited from your ancestors. And it was not paid with mere gold or silver, which lose their value. It was the precious blood of Christ, the sinless, spotless **Lamb of God.**

Revelation 5:6 NLT

Then I saw a **Lamb** that looked as if it had been **slaughtered**, but it was now standing between the throne and the four living beings and among the twenty-four elders. He had seven horns and seven eyes, which represent the sevenfold Spirit of God that is sent out into every part of the earth.

Jesus is the Lamb who **set you free** from sin and death

Romans 8:2 NLT

And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.
