Ephesians 1:7 (CEV)

Christ sacrificed his life's blood to set us free, which means that our sins are now forgiven. Christ did this because God was so kind to us. God has great wisdom and understanding,

It's not **what you do** that gets you into heaven.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NLT)

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. <sup>9</sup> Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.

Jesus paid the **price**, it is by **grace** you have been **saved**.

Romans 3:24 (NLT)

Yet God, with undeserved kindness, declares that we are righteous. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins.

All you do is **respond** to God's **grace**.

John 1:12 (NIV)

Yet to all who did receive him (Jesus), to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God—

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; **a new life** has begun!

Galatians 2:20 (NIV)

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Romans 6:6-8 (NLT)

We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin. <sup>7</sup> For **when we died with Christ** we were set free from the power of sin. <sup>8</sup> And since we died with Christ, we know we will also live with him.

Romans 6:11 (NLT)

So you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:1 (NLT)

So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.

You are a **new person**. Your old life is **gone**, forgiven. A **new life** has begun.

**Worshipping** God in all things as a **living sacrifice!**

Romans 12:1 (NLT)

And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.
