5. He Is a **Prophet** (*an inspired teacher or proclaimer of the will of God*)
 - a) He Declares the Word of God to His Family

Genesis 35:18 NLT

Rachel was about to die, but with her last breath she named the baby Ben-oni (which means "son of my sorrow"). The baby's father (Jacob), however, called him Benjamin (which means "son of my right hand").

- b) He is Fully **Armored**

Ephesians 6:13-17 NLT

Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Warning to Fathers.... Don't Fight **NAKED!** *Put on the full armor of God.*

- c) He loves God with all his **heart**, all his **soul**, and all his **strength**.

Deuteronomy 6:5-9 NLT

...you must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
