3. It’s too **controversial**.

2 Timothy 3:16 NLT

All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.

2,000 references in the Old Testament relate to the **end times**

Every book of the New Testament refers to the **second coming of Jesus**

What did Jesus really teach about the future? **Keep Watch!!**

Matthew 25

Matthew 25:13 NLT

“So you, too, must keep watch! For **you do not know** the day or hour of my return.”

**We need to be alert, anticipating the return of Jesus.**

John 14:2-3 NLT

There is more than enough room in my Father’s home. If this were not so, would I have told you that **I am going to prepare a place for you**? When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.

Acts 1:10-11 NLT

As they strained to see him rising into heaven, two white-robed men suddenly stood among them. “Men of Galilee,” they said, “why are you standing here staring into heaven? Jesus has been taken from you into heaven, but someday he will return from heaven in the same way you saw him go!”
