day and **seem** delighted to learn all about me. They **act** like a righteous nation that would never abandon the laws of its God.

Isaiah 58:2-3 NLT

They ask me to take action on their behalf, pretending they want to be near me. ‘We have **fasted** before you!’ they say. ‘Why aren’t you **impressed**? We have been **very hard** on ourselves, and you don’t even notice it!’

Isaiah 58:3-5 NLT

“I will tell you why!” I respond. “It’s because you are fasting to please yourselves. Even while you fast, you keep **oppressing** your workers. What good is fasting when you keep on fighting and quarreling? This kind of fasting will never get you anywhere with me. You humble yourselves by going through the motions of penance, bowing your heads like reeds bending in the wind. You dress in burlap fasting and cover yourselves with ashes. Is this what you call fasting? Do you really think this will please the LORD?”

Isaiah 58:6-8 NLT

“No, this is the kind of fasting I want: **Free** those who are wrongly imprisoned; **lighten the burden** of those who work for you. Let the oppressed go free, and **remove the chains** that bind people. **Share your food** with the hungry, and **give shelter** to the homeless. **Give clothes** to those who need them, and **do not hide from relatives** who need your help. “**Then** your salvation will come like the dawn, and your wounds will quickly heal. Your godliness will lead you forward, and the glory of the LORD will protect you from behind. **Then** when you call, **the LORD will answer**. ‘Yes, I am here,’ he will quickly reply.”

Isaiah 58:10 NLT

Feed the hungry, and **help those in trouble**. Then your light will shine out from the darkness, and the darkness around you will be as bright as noon.

Isaiah 58:11 NLT

The LORD will guide you continually, giving you water when you are dry and **restoring** your strength. You will be like a **well-watered garden**, like an **ever-flowing spring**.
