God does not change.

Malachi 3:6-12 NLT

Tithing was before The **Law**.

Genesis 14:18-20 NLT

And Melchizedek, the king of Salem and a priest of God Most High, brought Abram some bread and wine. Melchizedek blessed Abram with this blessing: "Blessed be Abram by God Most High,

Creator of heaven and earth.

And blessed be God Most High,

who has defeated your enemies for you."

Then Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of all the goods he had recovered.

Genesis 28:22 NLT

"And this memorial pillar I have set up will become a **place for worshiping God**, and **I will present to God a tenth** of everything he gives me."

Leviticus 27:30 NLT
