

But the word of our God stands forever.”


2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NKJV)

Matthew 4:1-4 (NKJV)

Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.' "

Jesus was **led** by the Spirit.

Why was Jesus in the Wilderness?

He was **following** God's will!

That's what you do when the Spirit **leads** you!

Does His Spirit lead you? Or is He just **in** you?

Jesus **followed** the Spirit - so **must** we!

Why was He led into the wilderness?

To be tempted by the devil.

God had a **purpose**.

For Jesus to experience what God's other Children face - **temptation!**

The Devil was 'lying in wait' - He waited for Jesus to **fast**.

The Devil knew what he was doing - he **always** knows.

Because the hunger was real - Christ's **suffering** was real.

Jesus, who is **God** living as man; is no **ordinary** man!

Jesus was **virgin-born** - **both** God and man.

Matthew 4:4 (NKJV)

....Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.

The Bible **alone** provides Godly answers to life's most basic questions.

Genesis 1:26 (NKJV)

... let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

John 14:1-3 (NKJV)

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also.

Are you willing to risk everything for God?

The Bible is **unifying**, **indestructible**, **universal** in influence.

It is **historical**, **scientific**, **prophetic**.

It has marvelous **life-giving** power.

Supernaturally, the Bible is the world's greatest book of faith.

John 14:9 (NKJV)

Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV)

Trust in the LORD with all your heart,
And lean not on your own understanding;
In all your ways acknowledge Him,
And He shall direct your paths.

Acts 2:38 (NKJV)

Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
