We think about the cross each Sunday as we participate in the **Lord's Supper**.

In talking about the events on the cross, we delve into the realm of **metaphysical**.

Our Scripture text: "God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God." 2 Corinthians 5:21

On the cross **Jesus** became **sin** itself.

The apostle was a very **precise** writer. He was not **careless** in his choice of words.

In 2 Corinthians 5:21, Paul did not write <u>sin</u> when he actually meant <u>sinner</u>.

What is the significance of that distinction?

God loves the \_\_\_\_\_, but He hates the \_\_\_\_\_.

On the cross Jesus became what His Father **hated**.

Jesus' prayer in Gethsemane. "Father, if you are <u>willing</u>, take this <u>cup</u> from me."

Jesus anguish in Gethsemane was so intense that <u>drops of blood</u> oozed from His <u>pores</u>.

Do you think Jesus would have had such intense anguish over physical death?

"Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani. My <u>God</u>, my <u>God</u>, what have you **forsaken** me?" Matthew 27:46

On the cross, Jesus quoted a Psalm. What was that Psalm? Why do you think He didn't quote Psalm 23?

God turned <u>away</u> from His Son for a moment in time, and that moment Jesus experienced <u>hell</u> for us.
